RESOLUTION NO. 113

RESOLUTION EXPRESSING FULL SUPPORT TO THE NATIONAL AND MOH-BARMM DEPLOYMENT AND VACCINATION PLANS FOR COVID-19 VACCINES AND URGING ALL GOVERNMENT UNITS, AGENCIES AND INSTRUMENTALITIES IN THE BANGSAMORO AUTONOMOUS REGION TO PROVIDE FULL COOPERATION INCLUDING ADVOCACY, EDUCATION AND INFORMATION CAMPAIGN FOR ITS SUCCESSFUL IMPLEMENTATION

WHEREAS, the COVID-19 pandemic continues to spread throughout practically all nooks and corners of the world, in the Philippines including the BARMM areas, thus persisting to create social and economic havoc and threat to human lives;

WHEREAS, under the principle of moral governance, the BARMM government ensures the conduct and implementation of its duties and responsibilities as prescribed under Section 22, Article IX of Republic Act No. 11054 otherwise known as the "Organic Law for the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao", that is to provide for a comprehensive and integrated health service delivery for its constituents and establish by law a general hospital system to serve the health requirements of its people and ensure that the individual basic right to life shall be attainable through the prompt intervention of excellent and affordable medical services;

WHEREAS, the national government has formulated the Philippine Deployment and Vaccination Plan for COVID-19 Vaccines and in strong advocacy thereof, the BARMM Government through the Ministry of Health has followed suit with the adoption and formulation of the BARMM Deployment and Vaccination Plan including the allocation of Five Hundred Million Pesos (Php 500 Million) for the procurement of related legally authorized safe vaccines;

WHEREAS, the herein-mentioned national and BARMM plans provide intensive and extensive procedures and mechanisms for the efficient implementation of the COVID-19 vaccination program and do not constitute acts contrary to the Islamic beliefs and practices as well as the religious faith of all other Bangsamoro constituents;

WHEREAS, there is a need to elicit the full support and participation of all government units, agencies and instrumentalities, concerned private sector as well as the entire Bangsamoro constituents to the afore-mentioned vaccination plans including but not limited to the aspect of risk communication and community engagement to enhance community awareness on the importance of the program;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it

RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved by the Bangsamoro Transition Authority, to express full support to the National and MOH-BARMM deployment and vaccination plans for covid-19 vaccines and urging all government units, agencies and instrumentalities in the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region to provide full cooperation including advocacy, education and information campaign for its successful implementation.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, to forward this Resolution to all Bangsamoro Ministries, for information and appropriate consideration.
