RESOLUTION EXPRESSING THE RECOGNITION AND COMMENDATION OF THE BANGSAMORO PARLIAMENT TO DR. FATIMA TASNEEM JIMLOK MOHAMMAD SALI FOR TOPPING THE 2021 PHILIPPINE BOARD OF EMERGENCY MEDICINE IN-SERVICE EXAMINATION

WHEREAS, Fatima Tasneem "Tam" Jimlok Mohammad Sali, MD, a Resident of Ospital ng Makati's Department of Emergency, topped the 2021 Philippine Board of Emergency Medicine (PBEM) In-Service Examination, a professional licensure examination for a specialized discipline in the medical field focused on giving timely and coordinated health and safety services to victims of sudden illness or injury;
