FORMULATION OF THE 2<sup>ND</sup> BANGSAMORO DEVELOPMENT PLAN

(BDP), RESULTS MATRICES (RM) AND THE BANGSAMORO DEVELOPMENT INVESTMENT PROGRAM (BDIP), 2023-2028

- In 2019, the Bangsamoro Government formulated its 1<sup>st</sup> Bangsamoro Development Plan which serves as the roadmap for the development of the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao (BARMM). The 1<sup>st</sup> BDP outlined the priority thrusts and development direction of the Bangsamoro Government covering the period of 2020 to 2022.
- 2. Since the plan coverage of the 1<sup>st</sup> BDP ends in 2022, a successor plan shall be formulated by the Bangsamoro Government to sustain the gains and pursue the development direction, priorities, and strategies outlined in the 1<sup>st</sup> BDP 2020-2022.
- 3. The successor plan shall be known as the  $2^{nd}$  Bangsamoro Development Plan covering the period of 2023 to 2028. The  $2^{nd}$  BDP is a medium-term plan that will outline the development priorities of the Bangsamoro Government for the three-year extension of the transition period and beyond.
- 4. The formulation of the 2<sup>nd</sup> BDP 2023-2028 is also in time for the formulation of the six-year medium-term plan at the national level that will also outline the development agenda, thrusts, and priorities of the new leadership following the assumption of the next President after the national election in May 2022.
- 5. The formulation of the plan shall be consistent and aligned with the recently approved Enhanced 12-Point Priority Agenda of the BARMM and national development thrusts and priorities. It shall also ensure horizontal and vertical alignment and integration of plans and priorities addressing pressing issues at the local levels. Hence, all ministries, line agencies, and offices shall draw inputs from their respective provincial

and municipal counterparts, LGUs, and other development stakeholders at the local levels.

- 6. The plan shall also ensure mainstreaming of gender, disaster risk reduction and management and climate change adaptation (DRR/CCA), and other cross-cutting concerns. With the threat of the COVID-19 pandemic and the "new normal", the plan shall also integrate development priorities and interventions as stipulated in the Bangsamoro Response and Recovery Plan to sustain the development efforts, facilitate recovery from the effects of the COVID-19 pandemic and ensure the resiliency of the region's populace to possible threats caused by emerging or reemerging infectious diseases.
- 7. The 2<sup>nd</sup> BDP formulation process shall be spearheaded by the **Bangsamoro Economic and Development Council (BEDC) through its five sectoral committees** with the assistance of the **Bangsamoro Planning and Development Authority (BPDA-BARMM)** being the technical secretariat of the BEDC.
- 8. The BEDC sectoral committees shall serve as the planning committees in the formulation of the 2<sup>nd</sup> BDP 2023-2028. As such, the sectoral committees shall have the following functions and responsibilities, to wit:
  - a. Identify and agree on the content of the Plan chapters and sections;
  - b. Meet with the provincial/municipal counterparts and other stakeholders during provincial consultations to discuss possible convergence and generate inputs for the 2<sup>nd</sup> BDP;
  - c. Consolidate and harmonize for consistency, the chapters/sections drafted by their respective sub-committees/TWGs, and ensure that sectoral and local (provincial/municipal) contribution to the attainment of the overall thematic outcome is reflected;
  - d. Review and finalize the 2<sup>nd</sup> BDP chapter write-up, Result Matrix (RM) and Bangsamoro Development Investment Program (BDIP);
  - e. Create a Sectoral sub-committee or Technical Working Group, as necessary to assist the Sectoral committee in the drafting of the Plan and its RM and BDIP;
  - f. Clear and review the write-up/RMs and BDIP that are formulated and updated by the Sectoral Committee sub-com/TWG; and
  - g. Prepare and present the updated draft 2<sup>nd</sup> BDP chapters during the BEDC Sectoral Committees' Meeting and/or Cabinet meetings.

The Sectoral Sub/Committee or Technical Working Groups shall have the following functions:

- a. Prepare draft textual content, RM, strategic framework, and BDIP of the assigned sections in their respective chapters;
- b. Present the draft updated Chapter's section write-up during the Sectoral Committee meetings; and
- c. Revise and finalize the Chapter's section write-up incorporating comments derived from the various consultations.

- 9. The Bangsamoro Planning and Development Authority as the Technical Secretariat of the BEDC Sectoral Committees is directed to spearhead the coordination of plan formulation, consolidation of the planning outputs, and packaging of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Bangsamoro Development Plan and its accompanying documents in close coordination with the BEDC Sectoral Committees.
- 10. With this, all ministries, agencies, and offices are hereby directed to prioritize, support, and actively participate in the formulation of the 2<sup>nd</sup> BDP and its accompanying RM and BDIP, 2023-2028.
