1. The **18-Day Campaign to End VAW** supports the Philippine Government's goal of protecting the human rights of women and girls by upholding its commitment to address all forms of gender-based violence as enshrined in the 1987 Constitution. By virtue of Republic Act 10398 or the Act declaring November 25 of every year as the National Consciousness Day for the Elimination of VAWC, government agencies are mandated to raise awareness on the problem of violence and the elimination of all forms of violence against women and girls.
2. The **Bangsamoro Women Commission (BWC)**, in partnership with the **Bangsamoro Transition Authority - GAD Focal Point System (BTA-GFPS)**, **Bangsamoro Sports Commission (BSC)**, and the **City Government of Cotabato**, will be organizing a fund-raising initiative through a fun-run activity: **"United for a VAW-Free Bangsamoro: Run for A Cause" on December 10, 2022.**
3. Relative to this, all ministries, agencies, and offices through its GAD Focal Point System are hereby directed to register *at least five (5) personnel* from their respective offices, charged against their 5% GAD budget.
4. All proceeds of this fund-raising activity will be donated to selected Women Peace Centers or shelters/housings for the victim-survivors of VAW in BARMM.

Note: There will be three (3) winners: the top three runners per category, who will win cash and medals.

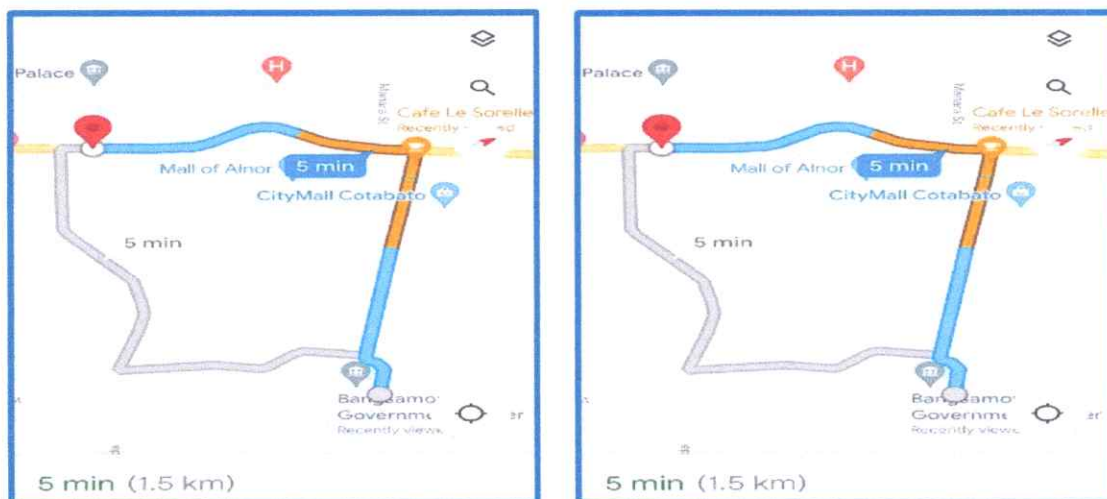
III. Route (3K Run, 5K Run and 10K Run)

The starting line for the run will be on the left side of the OCM Building (facing it) and in front of the CSC Court. The Finish line will be on the other side, facing the Ministry of Public Works (MPW) office building.

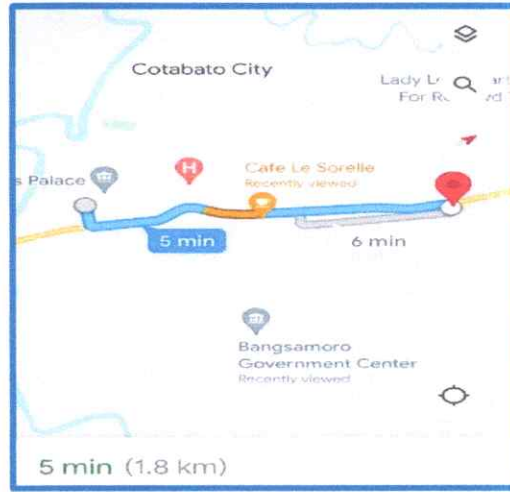
Traffic Marshalls must be located at every station and intersection of the routes. Water stations will be placed at strategic locations, together with tag/ribbon holders. Runners must get tag/ribbons at given points as proof that they passed by that point. Tarps must also be placed at strategic points.

The two right lanes of the roads were proposed as lanes to be used for the runners. Two (2) police sweepers (wang-wang) per category will guide the runners.

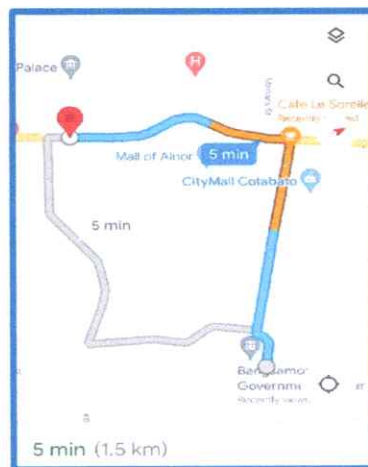
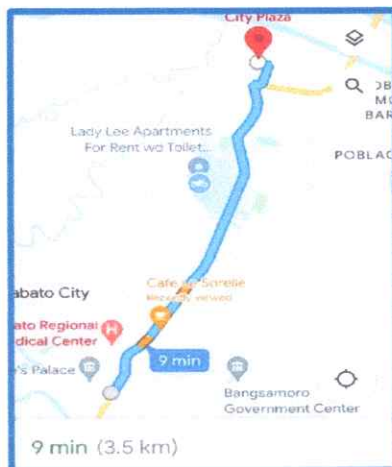
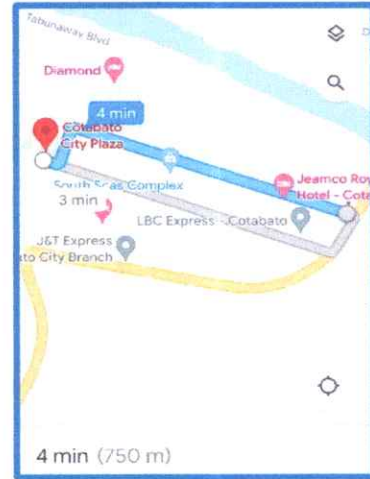
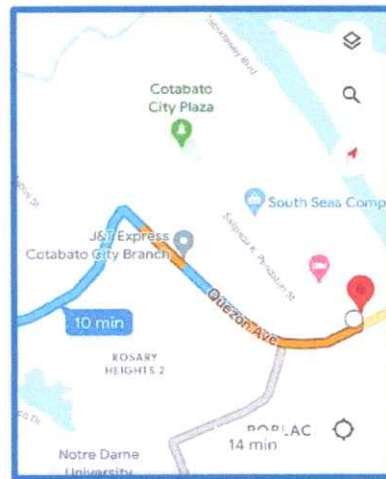
A. 3K Run - ORC straight to Jollibee Drive-thru Sinsuat Avenue, turn left to People's Palace and back. (1.5km x 2 = 3km)



B. 5K Run - ORC straight to Jollibee Drive-thru Sinsuat Avenue, turn right to Mercury Drugstore Santos St., U-turn from Mercury straight to People's Palace and U-turn back to ORC. (1.7km + 1.8km + 1.5km = 5km)



C. 10K Run - ORC straight to Jollibee Drive-thru Sinsuat Avenue, then turn right to town. Upon reaching BSP, turn right to Quezon Ave until Jollibee, then turn left to Don Rufino Alonzo Street. Go straight to the Cotabato City Plaza. Go back to Sinsuat Avenue and straight to People's Palace and U-turn back to ORC. (4.2km + .8km + 3.5km + 1.5km = 10km)



IV. Participants

The fun run will be open to all BARMM residents who at least 18 years old and physically healthy. A minimum of 600 to a maximum of 1,000 participants are expected to join the activity.

- ◆ 10 participants from each of the ministries and offices of the Bangsamoro Government; registration of said participants shall be charged in their office's 5% GAD budget.
- ◆ 100 participants pledge by the BTA; 50 participants by the BWC; 50 participants by the City LGU; and 50 participants by the BSC. These are apart from the 10 participants each office will cover registration for the activity.

V. Organizers and Partners

The activity was initiated by the Bangsamoro Transition Authority through its Gender and Development.

Focal Point System (GADFPS). It will be organized by the BTA-GADFPS in partnership with the City Government of Cotabato, the Bangsamoro Women Commission, and the Bangsamoro Sports Commission with support from all the ministries and offices of the Bangsamoro Government.
