SECURITY GUIDELINES INSIDE THE BANGSAMORO GOVERNMENT

CENTER DURING THE PERIOD OF FILING OF CERTIFICATE OF

CANDIDACY FOR THE MAY 2025 ELECTIONS

 This Memorandum Circular is issued to provide for the security guidelines during the period of Filing of Certificates of Candidacy for the May 2025 Elections on 01 to 08 October 2024 at the Shariff Kabunsuan Cultural Complex (SKCC) and Commission on Elections (COMELEC) Office in the Bangsamoro Government Center (BGC), Cotabato City.

2. To ensure safety and orderliness inside the BGC, the following guidelines shall be strictly observed.

a. General Guidelines

- i. As provided under Memorandum Circular No. 111 s. 2024, all BARMM ministries, offices, and agencies with offices inside the BGC may adopt appropriate alternative work arrangements.
- ii. Backpacks or handbags shall be inspected upon entry at the front gate.
- iii. Carrying of firearms is strictly prohibited.
- iv. Jogging and other recreational activities are strictly not allowed during this period.
- v. Curfew hours shall be observed from 10:00 pm to 5:00 am.

b. Guidelines for Vehicles

- All vehicles, with the exception of those mentioned in the succeeding item, must enter and exit through the back gate along Gonzalo Javier Street.
- Officials of the Bangsamoro Government (Members of the Parliament, Ministers, Deputy Ministers, and those holding directorial positions or higher) may enter their vehicle through the main gate of the BGC,

provided they secure a **Special Vehicle Pass** from the Intelligence and Security Service (ISS) of the Office of the Chief Minister. The Special Vehicle Pass may be availed at the ISS from September 28 to 30, 2024.

- iii. Members of the Parliament, Ministers, and Deputy Ministers may only avail two (2) special vehicle passes, while those holding directorial positions or higher may only avail one (1).
- iv. Employees may only enter their vehicle through the back gate along Gonzalo Javier Street, provided that they present their vehicle pass and office ID to the security officer upon their entry.
- v. From 9 AM onwards, vehicles will no longer be allowed to enter through the back gate.
- vi. Strictly no parking of vehicles at the area fronting the SKCC, and along the area from the corner street of the Ministry of Health BARMM (former DOH XII) and Bangsamoro Pilgrimage Authority to the street fronting the POPCOM XII.
- vii. Carpooling among employees is highly encouraged.

c. Guidelines for Employees and Walk-in Clients

- Coasters will be made available to ferry employees and walk-in clients from (1) Malagapas Access Road fronting the People's Palace and (2) APEX Gasoline Station along Sinsuat Avenue corner Doña Avelina Gutierrez Street to the Bangsamoro Government Center, and vice versa.
- ii. Employees and walk-in clients must present their office ID and valid ID, respectively, to the security officer upon their entry at the gate.
